Airport Economic Impact Study – Your Economy. Your Airport.

The Key finding of the Economic Impact Study:

In 2014, the total economic impact* of Greater Moncton International Airport was:

- **A total of \$665 million of economic activity annually**
(an increase of 75% since the last study done in 2008)

Additionally, there are a number of other key findings:

- 2798 local jobs supported by ongoing GMIA operations, translating to \$23 million in household income
- \$37 million in tax revenue generated:
 - \$6 million to the federal government;
 - \$22 million to the provincial government;
 - \$9 million to the municipal government

**Includes direct, indirect, and induced impacts.*

As the Greater Moncton Region grows, so does the Airport:

- In 2014, nearly 678,000 passengers travelled through the airport, representing a 15% increase since 2008.
- In 2014, over 25,000 thousand tonnes of cargo were lifted from the airport to Europe and Asia which is a 4% increase since 2008.
- Airport operators are meeting the growing demand through increased flights and improvements to the airport passenger experience. This includes terminal upgrades such as the current renovations to washrooms and terminal seating.

The airport as a facilitator to industry and community development:

- Aviation connectivity of both passengers and cargo enhances competitiveness and makes Greater Moncton an attractive location for businesses and visitors. For example:
 - Air access makes it possible to put Greater Moncton as a key player, with its central geographic location, by attracting new businesses in the region.
 - As a transshipment centre for logistics and transportation in the region, the Airport, with its partners, can deliver a cost effective way to ship time sensitive goods like seafood.
 - Visitors and tourists from around the globe arrive in New Brunswick through the doors of GMIA.
