Essential Functions

- Perform repair and maintenance of various airport equipment and systems including HVAC systems, aircraft loading bridges, airport conveyor systems, building related systems, overhead doors, automatic doors, doors, flooring, roofing, walls, siding, and plumbing systems.
- Ensure the maintenance and certification of life safety systems (elevator, sprinkler systems, fire alarm)
- Prepare specifications for work performed by outside vendors/contractors
- Perform key cutting, lock installation and maintenance
- Physical effort required which includes regularly or constantly standing, walking, using gross and fine motor skills, moving and lifting objects (e.g. occasionally required to lift objects or machinery up to 65 lbs and carrying objects up to 50 lbs), climbing ladders, using hand held tools and crouching and bending to work on various machines and equipment.
