All flights to:

Halifax (YHZ) are suspended until June 30

and Ottawa (YOW) are suspended until September 7

Porter Airlines extending their temporary suspension of flights until June 29.

AIR TRANSAT & SUNWING

All southbound flights from YQM with Air Transat and Sunwing are cancelled for the season
