Greater Moncton International Airport Authority (GMIAA) is continuing to monitor developments related to the spread of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19). The health and wellness of our passengers, visitors, business partners and employees are our top priority.

### **Airline Operations**

Reminder that our airline schedule may change at anytime, passengers are asked to contact their airline for the latest information about their flight.

### **WESTJET**<sup>∠</sup>

WestJet currently operates 3 days a week to Toronto (YYZ) on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays until May 31. The June schedule is anticipated to be a similar in frequency.

#### AIR CANADA<sup>∠</sup>

All flights to:

- Toronto (YYZ) & Montreal (YUL) routes are currently suspended until June 21 and expected to resume activity June 22.
- Update: Halifax (YHZ) is suspended until September 7 and Ottawa (YOW) is suspended as well until September 7. Both services are expected to resume activity September 8.

Porter Airlines flights are temporary suspended and expected to resume activity June 29.
