* **Update:** WestJet currently operates 3 days a week to Toronto (YYZ) on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays and will continue until August 4; however, beginning July 5 departures will change from 1500 to 1255.

AIR CANADA[∠]

All flights to:

- Toronto (YYZ) and Montreal (YUL) routes are currently suspended until June 21 and expected to resume activity June 22.
- Halifax (YHZ) and Ottawa (YOW) are suspended until September 7. Both services are expected to resume activity September 8.

PORTER[∠]

Porter Airlines flights are temporary suspended and expected to resume activity July 29.
