

Manager, Emergency Response & Planning

The Manager of Emergency Response and Planning is responsible for planning, organizing, directing, and controlling the Emergency Services and Emergency Planning Program. This position requires extensive knowledge of Federal Regulations, policies, and standards applicable to airport emergency response and emergency planning. The Manager of Emergency Response and Planning is responsible for providing managerial leadership and technical guidance to the supervisors (Fire and ARFF Captains) and staff of the Emergency Response and Planning department.

Essential Functions

- Enhance, maintain and implement the GMIAA Airport Emergency, Evacuation and Wildlife Plans and chair the Airport Emergency Planning Committee.
- Provide direct oversight and prioritization of all department activities to ensure that all
 applicable regulatory and training requirements are being met.
- Prioritize short and long-term activities with a focus on continuous improvement of the level of service provided to stakeholders.
- Prepare and administer the Emergency Response and Planning operating and capital budgets and approve operating and capital expenditures.
- Interpret and apply all relevant Government of Canada legislation, policies, codes and regulations and associated training requirements.
- Review commercial aircraft flight movement statistics as required to determine the critical category for firefighting as required by Canadian Aviation Regulation.
- Represent the Airport Authority with the City of Dieppe, Federal, Provincial, private and Municipal emergency response agencies on all emergency response matters, including regulatory matters.
- Develop and monitor the implementation of an effective facility Fire Prevention and Inspection Program.
- Develop and deliver internal training programs for Airport Authority staff on emergency scene roles and maintain required records.
- Respond to, and assume command of, major emergencies at the airport.

Qualifications

- A Certificate or Diploma in Fire Service Administration from a recognized program, a bachelor's degree program in Emergency Services is preferred or the equivalent work experience and training.
- A minimum of five years' experience in emergency response and planning in a supervisory or managerial capacity.
- In-depth knowledge of regulations, standards, policies and procedures related to airport emergency response and planning.
- Demonstrated excellent verbal and written communication skills.
