Job Purpose

The Seasonal Airfield Specialist works as part of a team that maintains various airport paved surface structures through a variety of snow removal heavy equipment. This position works 12-hour shifts of either days or nights, rotating on a monthly basis. We are currently seeking 2 individual(s) to work from November 11, 2024 until April 11, 2025. The position is recalled annually for the winter months for 75 hours bi-weekly, subject to operational requirements.

Overview of Duties

- Snow removal with the use of a variety snow plows, snow blowers, front end loaders, dump trucks with plow and wing attachments
- Performs routine maintenance of Airport premises, roads and lands, both airside and groundside
- Provides Emergency Response support as required
- Lifts equipment and supplies weighing up to 50lbs

Qualifications

- Heavy Equipment Operator: 5 Years
- Valid Class 3 driver's license with air brakes endorsement
- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Effective communication skills
- Ability to obtain Airside Vehicle Operators Permit, Transport Canada Security Clearance and Radio Operators License





Role is based in Dieppe, New Brunswick. The rate of pay is \$28.34 per hour to start with competitive benefits and availability for overtime.
